

Line Locating Training

One-Day Course

Fundamental Principles And Techniques in Buried Utility Locating: The purpose of this course is to instruct new and experienced people the proper use and care of a pipe and cable locator.

1. Different technologies used, what works, what doesn't
2. Theory of line locating
3. Types of locating – how to use them for the best results
4. Locating skills and how to apply them to a specific site
5. Solving locate problems
6. Site marking and documentation
7. Safety

Students will complete a combination of class and hands on training at selected locations. It is important that students dress appropriately for the weather.
